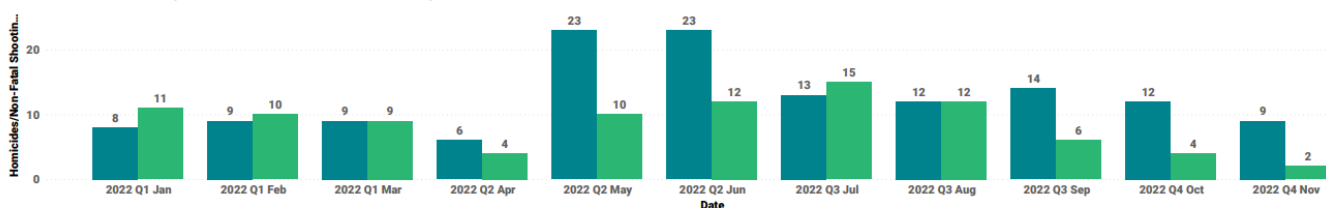

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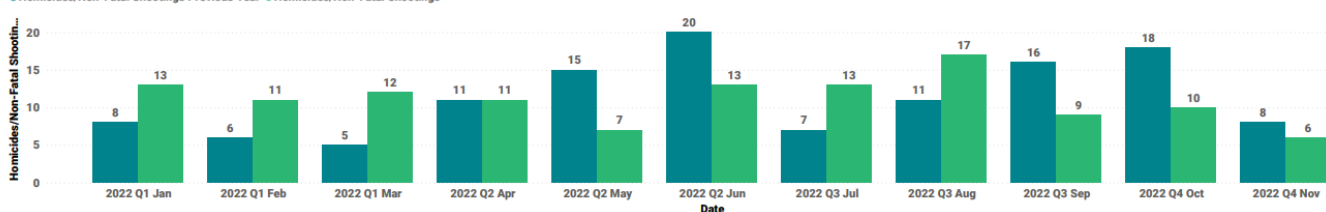
Western District: YTD Homicides and Last Year YTD Homicides

Southwestern District: YTD Homicides and Last Year YTD Homicides

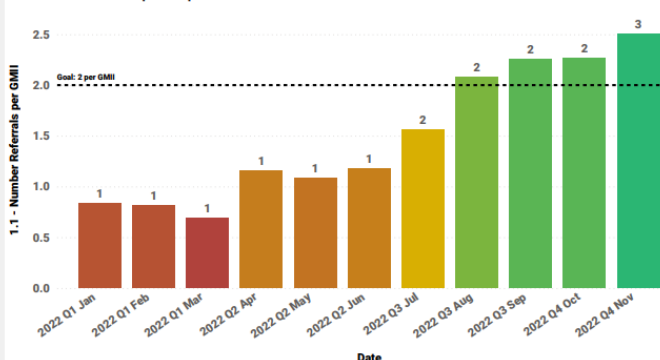

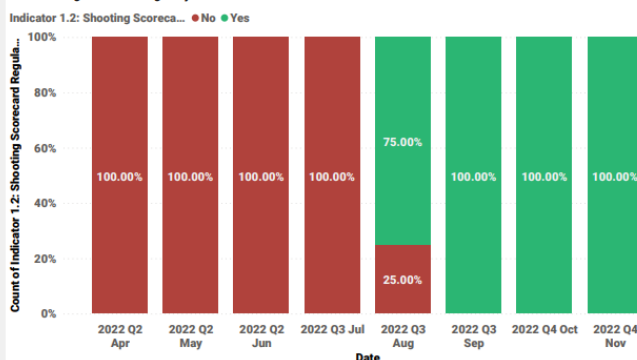

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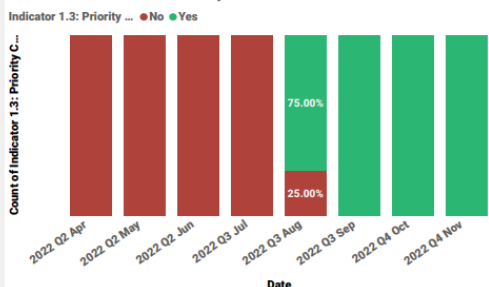
1.1: Number of Referrals per Group Member Involved Incident



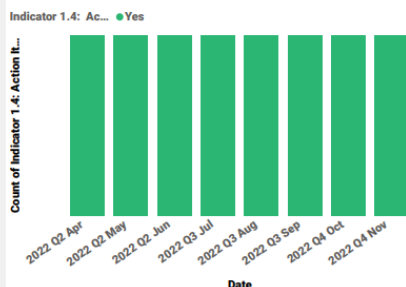
1.2: Shooting Scorecard Regularly Presented



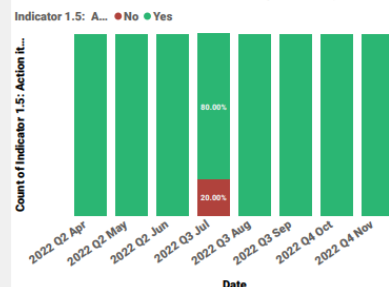

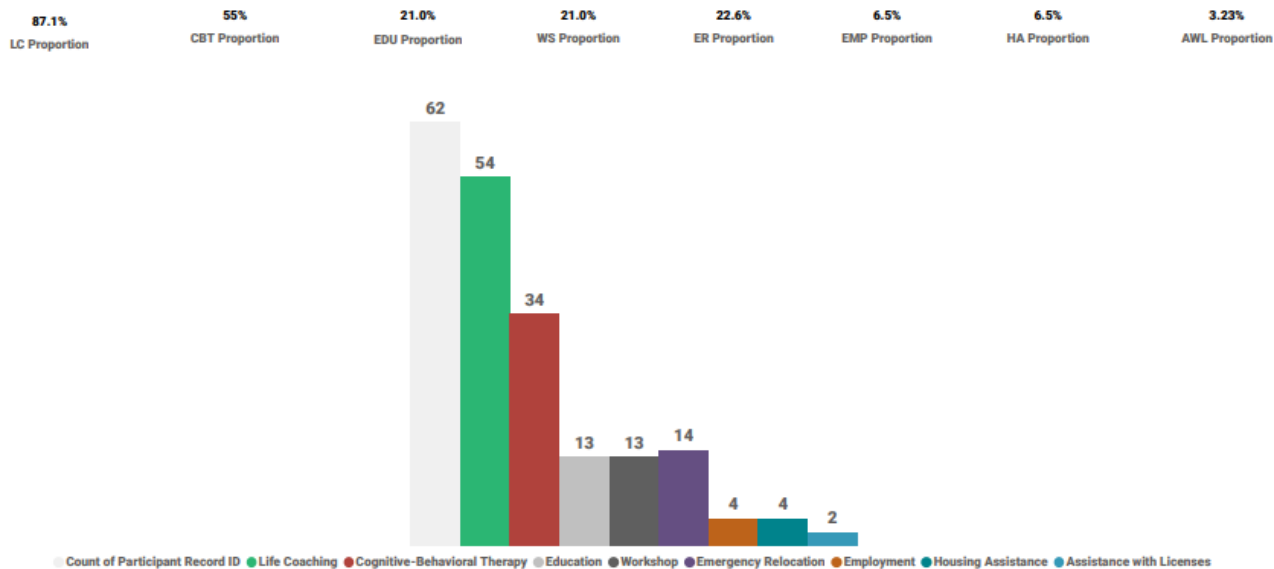

GVRs Services as a Proportion of Total Service-Receiving Participants

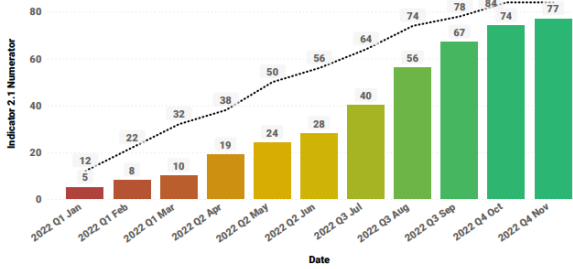




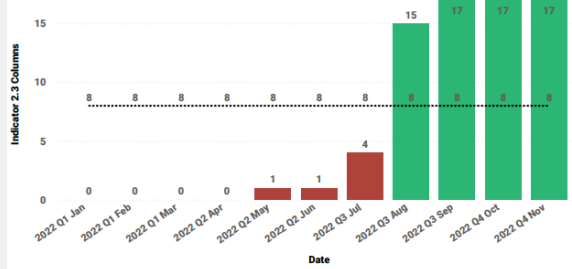

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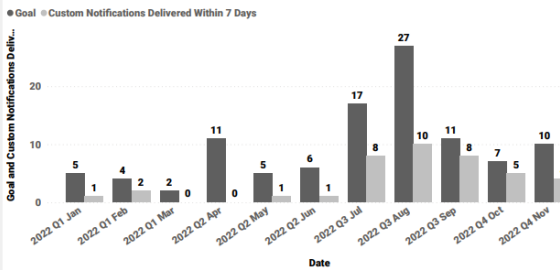
2.1: Full Custom Notifications Conducted Per Group Member Involved Incident



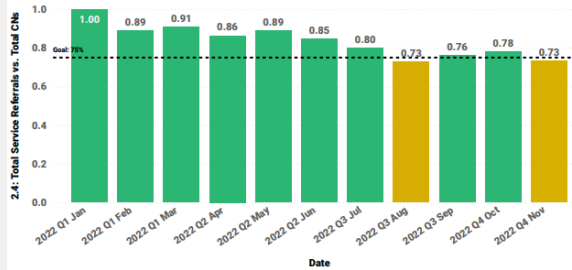
2.3: Custom Notifications Conducted Per Group Subject to Strategic Enforcement Investigation



2.2: Custom Notifications Delivered Within 7 Days of Referral Date



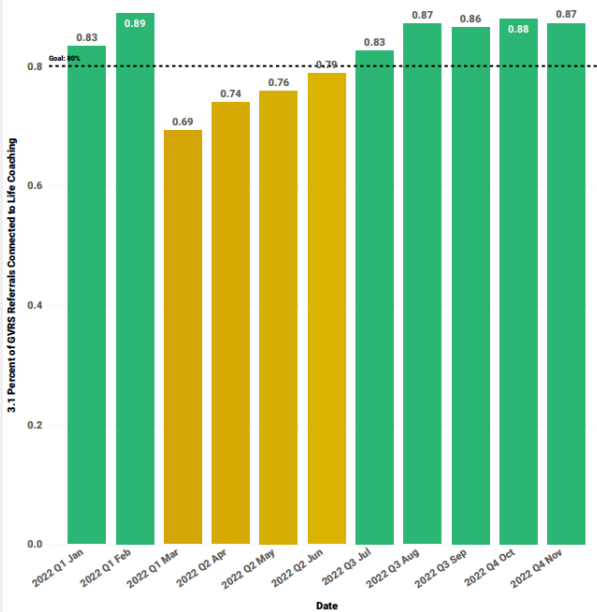
2.4: Percentage of Custom Notifications Turned Into Life Coaching Referrals



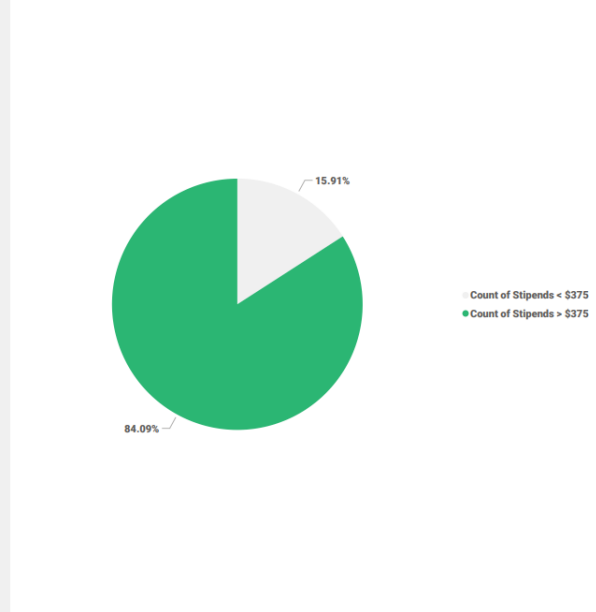

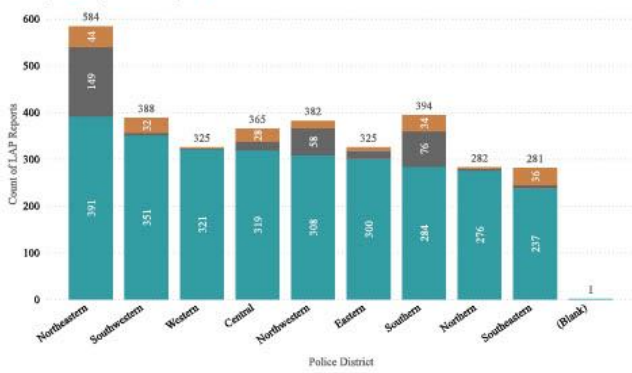
