Principal CJCC Members

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CJCC Workgroup Membership

- Workgroups will now be chaired by representatives from principal agencies. MONSE will be connecting with existing chairs and principal members in the coming weeks to make revisions to workgroup leadership, where necessary
- When the term of an elected principal member ends, the term of any representatives designated from that principal member's office will end unless they remain employed with the new administration. Representation in the workgroups will be at the new elected principal's discretion
- Former employees of principal agencies (both elected and non-elected) may not apply for workgroup membership as a private citizen

CJCC Workgroups

- As we head into Year 3 of the CJCC, the following workgroups will be active:
 - Community Justice (This is a newly-established workgroup focused on diversion, prevention, and innovative corrections)
 - Domestic Violence
 - Fines, Fees, and Restitution
 - Interagency Data and IT (This is a re-scoped workgroup, replacing the Public Safety Accountability Dashboard Workgroup)
 - Pretrial (to include home monitoring)
 - Warrants
 - CJCC principal members voted to dismantle and/or pause the following workgroups:
 - Transportation (This workgroup was formerly on hiatus due to lack of membership)
 - Backlog of Cases (This workgroup will be paused, pending participation by the Judiciary)
